


Word Search



SIMON PETER...

- Was born in Bethsaida
- Lived in Capernaum located on the Sea of Galilee
- Was married
- Was introduced to Jesus by his brother, Andrew
- Was a fisherman before he met Jesus
- Jesus changed His name to Cephas, which means "a stone"
- Walked on water to meet Jesus, but sank when he looked down at the water
- Preached on the day of Pentecost and saw 3,000 people trust Christ as Saviour
- Healed a lame beggar, Aeneas, and many who were sick through the power of Jesus
- Raised Dorcas from the dead by the power of Jesus
- One of three disciples at the mount when Jesus transfigured
