



HOW WILL I APPLY TODAY'S LESSON?

Do you remember what Moses had in his hand? (Allow response.) Moses had a simple shepherd's staff. His rod was not able to do miracles—it just allowed Moses to do his shepherding work. But when he gave his rod to God, what did God do? God used that simple rod to do miracles.



A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

Moses gave God excuses. He said the people wouldn't believe him. He said he couldn't speak well. He said, "Please God, send someone else!"

But God didn't want to send someone else—He wanted to use Moses. And He wants to use you. He wants to use you (and the tools you give Him) to show yourself and the world that God is God, and He is powerful.

Ask God, "What do I have that You could use to show Your power?" Then, give im the first thing He shows you, and allow Him to use it for His glory.
