A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

If Paul had been able to choose how he went to Rome, he probably would have chosen to go as a free man, rather than a prisoner. He probably would have chosen to have traveled on a boat he hired, rather than on a prison ship. He probably would have gone to the synagogue in Rome to preach, rather than having to have people come to him in the house where he was under arrest. But God worked through all the circumstances He brought Paul through.
