A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

What should you do when God's Word says something that is hard for you to obey? You should trust that God knows best, and He knows what will work out best in the end. You should read His Word, looking to find exactly what He wants you to do—how He wants you to speak, how He wants you to act in different situations, where He wants, or doesn't want, you to go. God knows the best answer for every part of your life, and you will find it if you listen to His Word.

You will never go wrong if, when God speaks (through His Word), you accept His Word as right, and realize that even if you are disappointed, He loves you and knows the very best thing for you.
