There was nothing but the rope that would save Rahab, and there is nothing but the blood of Jesus that will save us from our sins. So, how do we trust the blood of Jesus? How do we trust that Christ paid the death penalty for us? We simply believe.



### A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

When Rahab protected the spies and then asked them to protect her, God provided only one way for her to be protected—just one rope. She was to hang her scarlet rope out her window. Even though Rahab had rescued the spies, and even though Rahab wanted very badly to be rescued from destruction, and even though the spies had promised to save her and her family, if she hadn't tied the scarlet rope out the window, she would have been destroyed with the rest of her people. Just as Rahab had to trust God and put just one rope out her window to be saved, all we have to do to be saved from our sins is to trust the payment Jesus made for our sins. He shed His blood on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins—He paid our death penalty—and rose from the dead.
