



HOW WILL I APPLY TODAY'S LESSON?

Just as God showed all the Israelite people, including the false prophets of Baal, that He is all-powerful, He wants to show you His power. You will see His power through faith. And, as you allow Him to show you His power, and your faith grows, others will see His power through you! Elijah's God is our God, too!



A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

One Elijah against four hundred fifty prophets of Baal didn't seem like a fair contest, but the contest wasn't really between Elijah and Baal's prophets. The contest was between God and Baal. Elijah didn't need to be powerful to win the contest—he only needed to trust that God was powerful. Have you ever been like Elijah—standing alone for God when it seems no one else does? When we feel alone in our beliefs, we are often tempted to just go along with the people who don't believe God—the people who don't serve Him.

But Elijah's powerful God is the same God we have today. God stood with Elijah and worked through him to show His power, and He wants to do the same through you and me.
