



HOW WILL I APPLY TODAY'S LESSON?

Sometimes we try to hide from God when we are angry. We just decide to ignore God, acting like He isn't there. But all the while, our hearts grow emptier and emptier, and we miss seeing God's goodness. God never left Jonah, and He never leaves us. Even when Jonah was angry with God, Jonah couldn't get away from God, His love, His mercy, and His care, no matter where he went or what he did. Let's thank Him that we really can't hide from Him, because that means He is always with us!



A TRUTH TO REMEMBER FROM TODAY'S LESSON

God loved the Ninevites, and He wanted to use Jonah to share His message with them. But Jonah ran from God. He tried to hide. And when the Ninevites did choose to believe God, Jonah's heart was still hiding from God. He was happier about a plant that gave him shade than he was about thousands of people repenting and believing God. By hiding, Jonah missed so much that God wanted to do in his life.

It's easy for us to think that hiding is the best thing for us to do when we don't want to obey, but sooner or later there will be consequences.


