

**APPLY****HOW WILL I APPLY TODAY'S LESSON?**

If you believe God's Word, you will have times in your life when you will believe differently than the majority. You will be tempted, like the ten fearful spies, to look at what seems right, rather than looking at God, who is right.

But, remember how the ten spies were positive that they seemed so small (like grasshoppers) to the people of Canaan? God's Word, however, shows us that things are not always as they seem. What seemed like it was true to the ten fearful spies actually wasn't true at all.

**TRUTH****A TRUTH TO REMEMBER TODAY'S LESSON**

All the girls at school were excited about watching this new movie at McKenna's house next week—except for Taylor. As much as Taylor wanted to go, she knew there were some things in it that didn't please God. Taylor wondered, *But surely it would be OK if I watched just one little movie.*

Just then, McKenna walked up to Taylor, smirking. "Are you coming to my house?" she asked. "Did you decide about the movie?"

At McKenna's question, it seemed like all the girls at school started looking at Taylor. *What could it hurt? Everyone else is doing it,* Taylor thought. But slowly, she shook her head. Even though it was hard, even though she might be laughed at, she had to trust and obey God.

When we look at God's power and bigness instead of looking at the majority, we won't be afraid to believe Him. And, when we believe God, He will give us courage, strength, joy, peace, and all the other blessings that come to those who trust Him. Think about it—if the Israelites had looked to God instead of the Canaanites, they would have believed God, and God would have given them the Promised Land. Their lives would have been full of God's blessings. But instead, they lived lives of disappointment, not even knowing how much they were missing.

But what about us? If we choose to trust God like Taylor did, we'll have God's blessings. But if we don't, we'll never know how much we missed.
