The talent competition will be held on Friday morning. It will begin promptly at 8:00

Prizes

A Trophy will be awarded to the winning individual or group for each music related category, and each participant will receive a ribbon. For Example: the winning Ensemble will receive one trophy, but each participant will receive a ribbon. Second and third place in each category will also receive a ribbon.

The winner of the Bible Memory and Preaching competitions will receive a new Bible signed by all the conference speakers.

General Rules

Eligibility: any registered delegate that is not being considered a youth leader, worker, or chaperone.

Attire: Attire should be modest and appropriate. Men should wear long pants and a collared shirt. For Preaching contestants are encouraged, but not required, to wear a suit and tie. Ladies must wear a not shorter than knee length skirt or dress and a modest blouse.

Selections: For all vocal competitions the selection must be a Gospel song of Hymn appropriate for a Church service.

For instrumental competition a Gospel song or hymn is encouraged and preferred, however a classical selection is also acceptable.

Attendance: Once the competition has begun, the Administrator for each category will call the individual name or group that is next, as well as the one to follow. If that person or group is not present the administrator will move on to the next participant. If your name has been called at 3 separate times with no answer, you will be assumed as withdrawn from competition.

Categories

Vocal: Solo, Duet/Trio, Quartet, Ensemble (Quartet and Ensemble may be combined based on the number of entries)

Instrumental: Solo, Group (may be combined based on the number of entries)
