## The Teacher's Preparation

**Scripture Passages to Study:** Matthew 21:19-21; Mark 11:12-14; 20-21; John 15

**Study Guide:** Read "That Ye Bear Much Fruit: *The Expectation of Christ*" from *The Life of Christ - Part 2*.

**Lesson Objective:** In this lesson, the Bible tells us that Jesus was hungry and hoping to find figs, but He found only leaves on the tree. Just as a good fruit tree should produce good fruit, a good Christian should produce other good Christians. A Christian's main task is winning souls. Without Christ, we can do nothing; but with Him, we can bear fruit that will last for eternity.
