The Armor of God

The Teacher's Preparation

Scripture Passages to Study: Ephesians 6:10-24

Study Guide: Read "Spiritual Warfare: *The Armor of God*" from *New Testament Highlights - Part 1*.

Lesson Objective: In this lesson, Paul describes some parts of armor that were worn in the first century. Each part becomes a metaphor, or figure of speech, for the equipment a Christian needs in his spiritual warfare. No soldier should fight the enemy without his armor on. And no Christian is ready to fight the devil without putting on his spiritual armor.

Lesson Application: Just as armor helps the soldier be strong in battle, the spiritual armor that Paul tells us about helps me do right.
